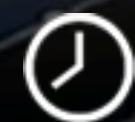
What is the trip about?

2 Day 1 Night Sailing Trip around the Rosario Islands.

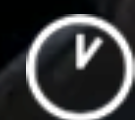
Experience living aboard and discover the magnificence of the Rosario archipelago marine life, culture and history.

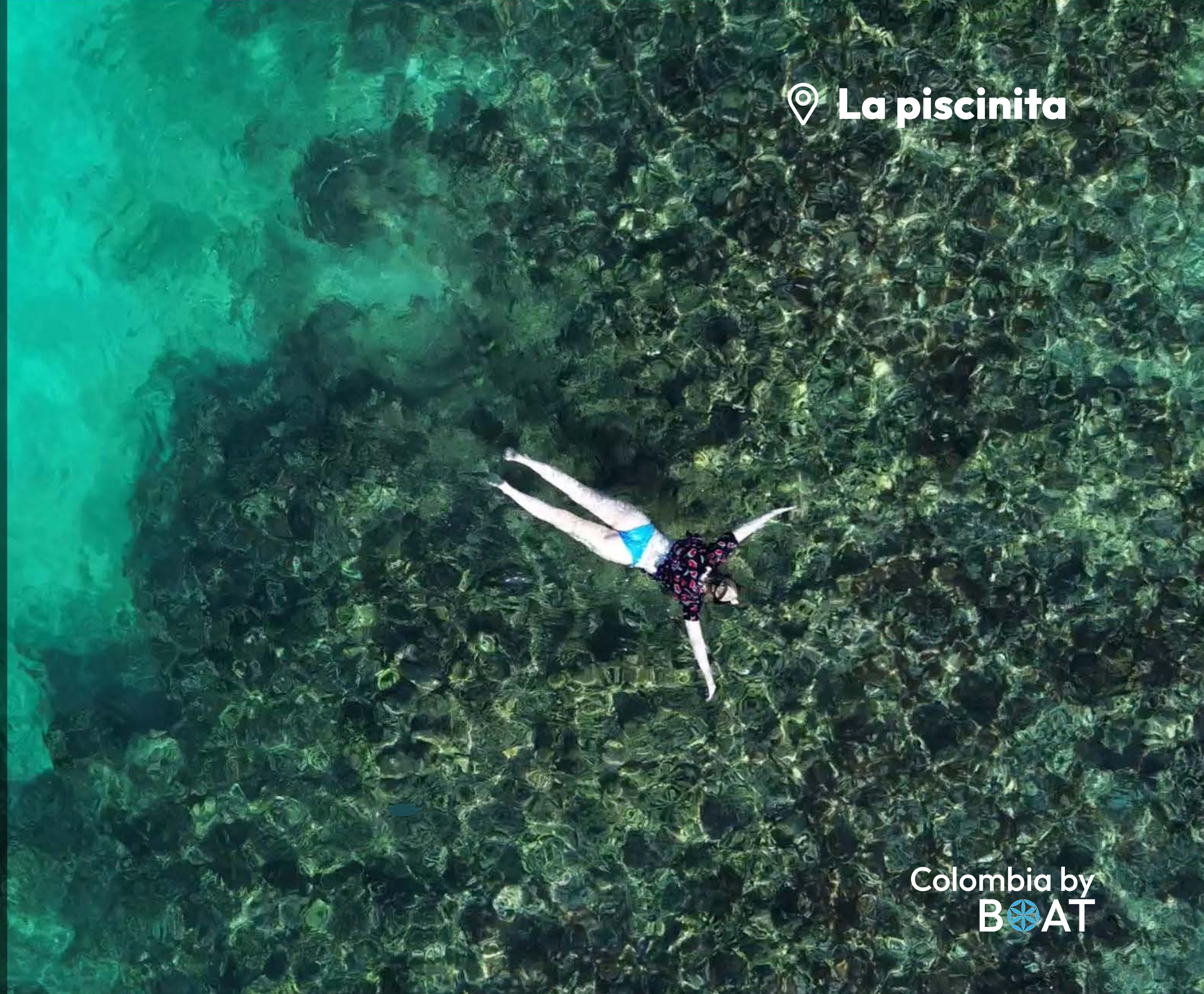

1 double bed in the saloon



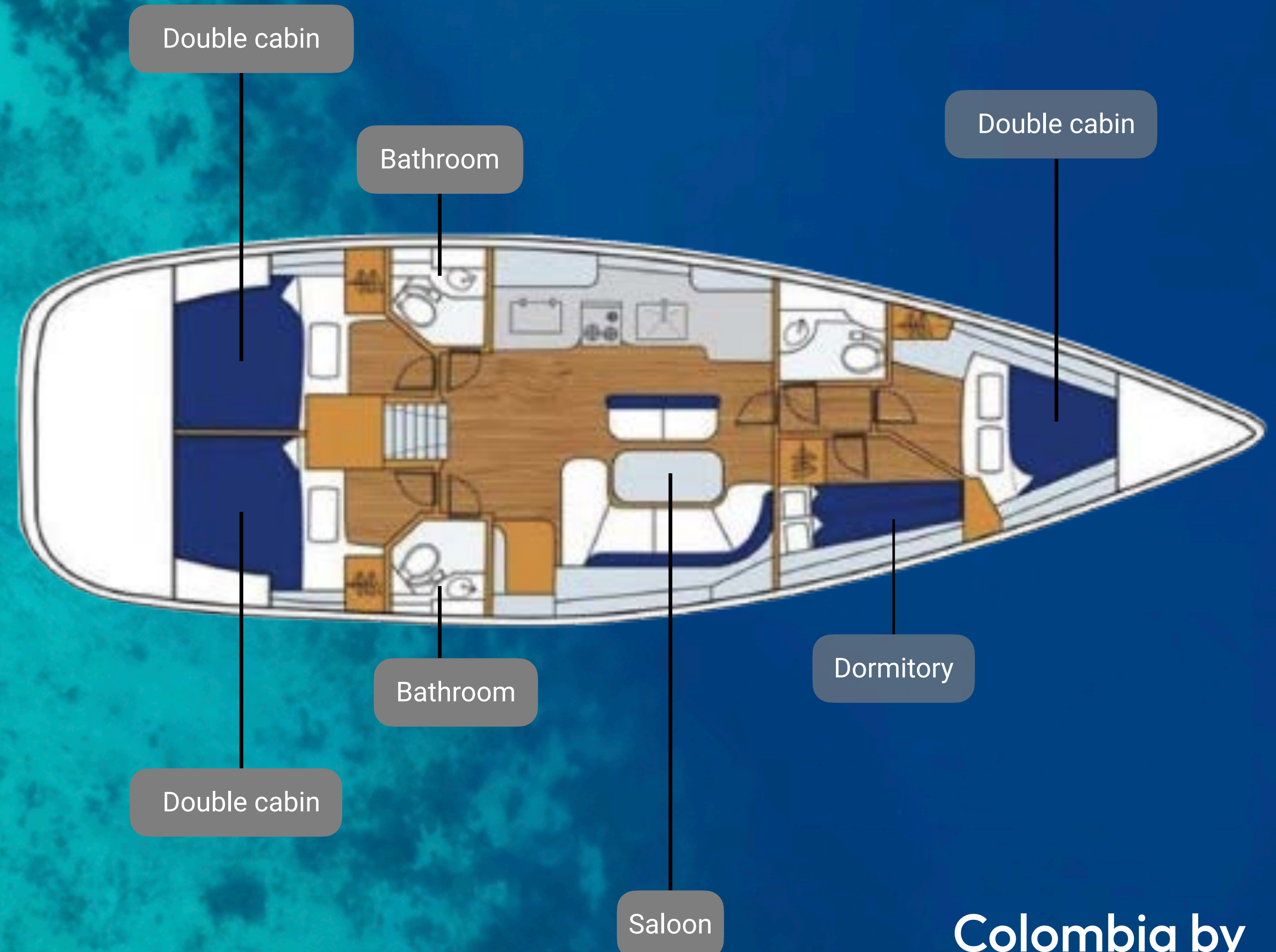
8 guests max

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How can I book?

- A deposit of \$150.000 COP per person is required to reserve a spot on board.
- The remaining balance can be paid in cash directly to the Captain on board. Payment via card or online link is possible (5% surcharge)
- Please ensure you have the correct amount of cash ready the day prior, as there is no ATM at the marina or the islands.
- Charges on cards will be in COP (Colombian pesos) according to the rate of the day at [XE.com](https://www.xe.com).

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What should I bring?

Bring: a small backpack with everything you will need for the trip, such as sun block, water bottle, hat, sun shirt, sun glasses, book, towel, rain jacket, snacks, mosquito repellent, flashlight, alcohol and mixers.

- *Bring your own medical supplies*
- *DO NOT bring: Large suitcases or luggage you won't use onboard, glass bottles (beers or soda), drugs or weapons.*

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How do I get to the boat and how much it cost?

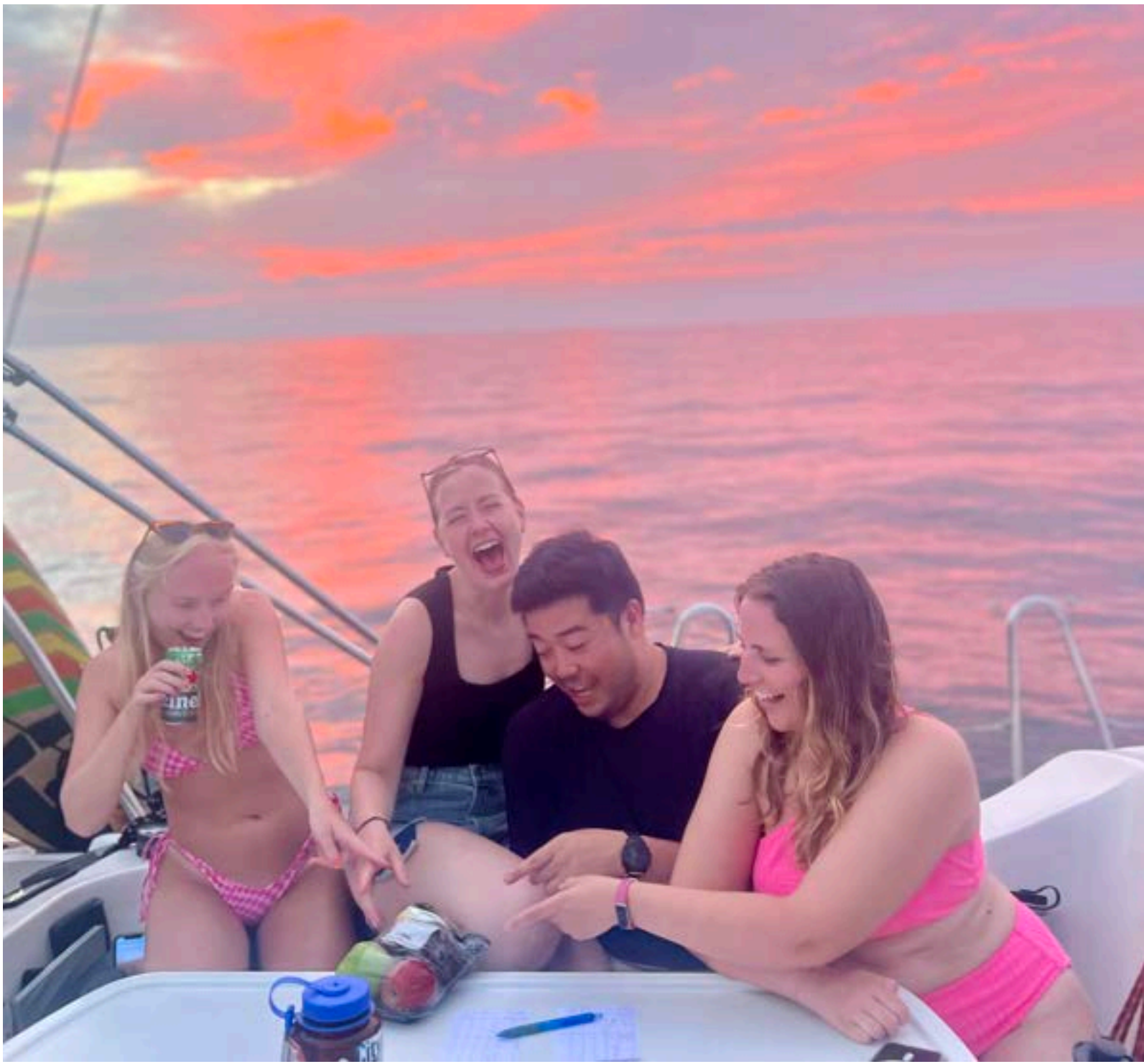
*Meeting point: Club Náutico De Cartagena,

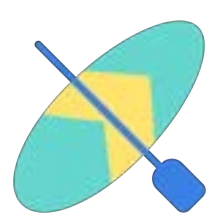

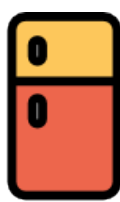

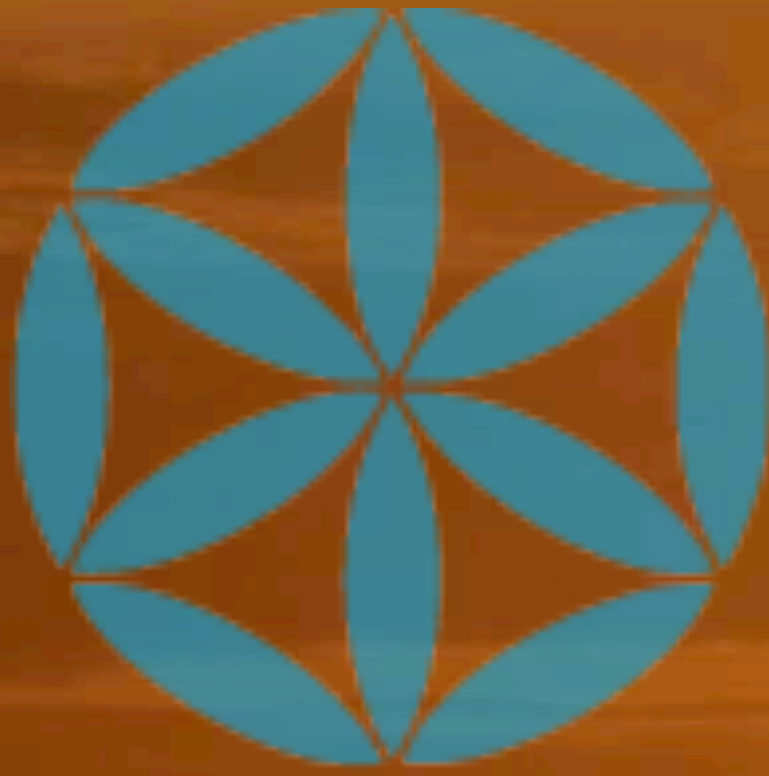
