

How can I book?

- · A deposit of \$150.000 COP per person is required to reserve a spot on board.
- The remaining balance can be paid in cash directly to the Captain on board. Payment via card or online link is possible (5% surcharge)
- · Please ensure you have the correct amount of cash ready the day prior, as there is no ATM at the marina or the islands.
- · Charges on cards will be in COP (Colombian pesos) according to the rate of the day at XE.com.





What should I bring?

Bring: a small backpack with everything you will need for the trip, such as sun block, water bottle, hat, sun shirt, sun glasses, book, towel, rain jacket, snacks, mosquito repellent, flashlight, alcohol and mixers.

- · Music playlist, instruments and speakers are always welcome onboard.
- · Bring your own medical supplies
- DO NOT bring: Large suitcases or luggage you won't use onboard, glass bottles (beers or soda), drugs or weapons.

Meeting point: Club Náutico De Cartagena, Colombia


